FARM CHARGES

BOARD: Includes stall and paddock use, cleaning of stalls, feeding, grooming, laundry and general care... \$500/mo.
Board less than one month... \$20/day
All other supplies ie. Grooming supplies etc... billed on occasion as a barn split.
Blacksmith, Veterinarian and special medication... As needed

Lessons: Boarders... \$40.00
Non-boarders... \$50.00
Non-boarders on Greyhaven horse... \$60.00

Training: Training Board... \$850/mo.
Noted as the best value w/ proven results. Includes your choice of either 3 lessons or 3 training rides or any combination of the of the two per week.

Group Lessons are also offered in addition to privates and can be billed separately as attended... \$40.00ea.

SHOW CHARGES

Tuition (Training on Show Days)

Boarders... \$50/day
Boarders each additional horse... \$40/day
Non-boarders... \$60/day
Non-boarders each additional horses... \$50/day

Day Care at Shows

Full care includes a groom to help tack up, hold horse at the ring and care of horse before and after showing.
Boarders (in addition to board)... \$40/day
Non-boarders (includes feed, etc.)... \$85/day

Rides at Shows

Boarders... \$30/class
Non-boarders... \$35/class

**Miscellaneous Expenses:**

Entering shows: per show, per horse.....	\$10.00
Full body clipping.....	\$125.00
Tack room, grooming stalls and decorations .....	Barn Splits
Staff expense (share of motel rooms).....	Barn splits
Shipping.....	Billed separate

**Lesson packages should be paid for at the beginning of the month. Make –ups are required within 30 days of cancellation. A “no show” fee will be applied for late cancellations on horseshows.**

**All other business ie. (full and partial leases, consignments , sales) conducted by contract only. Please consult with Jennifer on these subjects and any services not listed.**

**Clients are responsible for prompt payment of all show related expenses by independent \ contractors,(ie. Shipper, Vet, farrier, braiders)**

**Each individual is responsible for the care of his/ her own tack.**

**Hard hats are required at all times. And please, no jumping w/ out supervision.**

**Bills go out the end of every month to be remitted within the first week of the month. Balances carried past a 30 day period will be charged a 2% fee.**

## Here are some suggestions as to appropriate attire and conduct!

1. Barn Hours are Tuesday – Friday from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. We are closed on Monday.(Unless otherwise specified due to weather or horse shows)
2. All children must be supervised by an adult. It is mandatory for an adult to stay with a child during lessons.
3. Sideline coaching will not be tolerated. If there is sideline coaching from a parent or guardian, the student will be dismissed from the lesson. At the end of the lesson, an appointment will be made with the trainer to discuss the matter.
4. Running or screaming in the barn or around the horses will not be tolerated.
5. No shorts or sandals allowed when riding. The proper attire is paddock boots, jeans or breeches, t-shirts, polo shirts or a sleeveless shirt with a collar.
6. Jumping is only allowed during your lessons.
7. When flatting, please abide by the rules of etiquette. People in a lesson have the right of way. Horses/ponies jumping have the right of way.
8. Please clean up your grooming area. Put all brushes back. Clean up your horse/pony manure. Please clean **ALL** your tack and put it back on its hooks and racks.
9. Please throw away all trash.
10. Please return your horse/pony to its rightful stall and hang his halter up correctly. If it lives outside, please put it back outside. **DO NOT** leave a horse/pony outside by itself. They must be paired.
11. Please cancel lessons at least 24 hours in advance so we can make sure your horse/pony gets exercised. Lessons not canceled in advanced will be charged to the customer.
12. Please arrive at least 30 minutes before your lesson time for tacking and grooming.
13. Please leave ample time at the end of your lesson to properly cool and groom your horse/pony, and to clean and return your tack.

- \_\_\_\_\_ ASTM/SEI approved riding helmet (no plastic-style outer). Preferably Charles Owens, IRH or GPA.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Leather paddock boots in black or brown or tall boots in black.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Jeans & chaps (matching boot color), boots and breeches or paddock boots and jodphurs.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Black Gloves.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Hair nets.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Black crop.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Spurs and spur straps.

## **Supply list for shows, you will need to buy:**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Hunt Coat (Navy or other dark color, not black).
- \_\_\_\_\_ 1-2 long sleeve shirts (at least one white).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Boots and breeches or jodhpurs and paddock shoes.
